

SEASONS INSTRUCTIONS



A seasonal calendar describes the plants and animals that signal seasonal change in the landscape. Seasonal cycles described by different Aboriginal cultures vary according to location and act as a guide to what nature is doing throughout the year.

The six seasons of the Nyoongar Calendar have been portrayed by the Superhero Food character the Garden Guardian and provides an example for you to develop your own seasons. The Nyoongar country spans from Leeman in the northwest to beyond Cape Arid in the southeast, in the southwest of Australia.

Use the blank template to portray the seasons in your geographical location:

- Colour in the template to represent the colour of the season
- Add in the Aboriginal names for the season
- Include a brief description
- Include the location
- Include the time of year on the month/s sign




